



## Palm Beach Division Opens New 60,000 Sq. Ft. Facility

Waste Pro has expanded its Palm Beach facility into a new location at 7329 7th Place North in West Palm Beach. The 60,000+ square foot facility, with a 12,000+ square foot warehouse, will house Waste Pro's 166 employees in Palm Beach, in addition to more than 100 trucks. Overall, the new location sits on nearly ten acres of land just west of the Florida Turnpike and less than 10 miles away from the Palm Beach International Airport.

In addition to the new facility, Waste Pro is now servicing four new locations in Palm Beach County: The Town of Lantana, the Village of Palm Springs, the Town of Ocean Ridge, and the Village of Royal Palm Beach. In total, approximately 95,000 residential customers and 2,500 commercial customers are serviced out of the new facility.



## Waste Pro's Co-Heart Program Celebrates 200th Graduate

Waste Pro's Co-Heart Program, which trains team members to earn their commercial driver's license (CDL), has surpassed 200 graduates since its inception in 2015.

Corporate Operations Trainer Robert Bourcheau, a state-

approved examiner and instructor, works one-on-one with students of the Co-Heart Program to prepare for the CDL exam. The tests are conducted at Waste Pro's Regional Operations Center in Sanford, FL, a state-approved CDL testing site. Waste Pro is only one of two solid waste companies in Florida that works with the Florida Department of Transportation to offer such a program. Training includes advanced backing and driving skills, rollover prevention, and more.

In 2018, Waste Pro also opened two Driver Training Centers (DTC) for newly-hired drivers and employees who have recently obtained a CDL. Located in Sanford and the Atlanta, GA Regional Operations Center, the DTCs offer a five-day education course on topics including safety, vehicle specifics, and customer service.



## Waste Pro Launches Sponsorship with the Memphis Grizzlies

Waste Pro has signed a three-year sponsorship as the Official Waste Services Provider to the Memphis Grizzlies and FedExForum. The partnership began during the current 2019-2020 NBA season and will continue through the 2021-2022 season.

The Laptops for Veterans Program, which began in 2009, provides wounded members of the military and their families with new computers that can be used to communicate with loved ones during recovery, for education enhancement and personal development, to find jobs, and to research current events.

## Waste Pro's Louisiana Operations Awarded for Being Eco-Friendly

The Southeast Louisiana Clean Fuel Partnership has recognized Waste Pro as one of the top Clean Fleet leaders in the region. Waste Pro was selected for its efforts to reduce traditional fuel consumption "through the use of alternative fuels, fuel-saving technologies, and innovative transportation programs." Waste Pro also earned this recognition in 2018.

In 2011, Waste Pro invested \$100 million in compressed natural gas (CNG) powered collection and recycling trucks, which provide an eco-friendly alternative to diesel fuel by reducing emissions. Waste Pro now has seven CNG fueling stations and more than 300 CNG trucks in its fleet across its ten-state footprint.



## Waste Pro Begins Service in Hendersonville, TN

Waste Pro continues to grow in Tennessee. In May, the City of Hendersonville selected Waste Pro for a five-year term as its new solid waste provider, with services beginning in July. The city's selection of Hendersonville led to the opening of the new Nashville facility just 15 minutes away from the Capitol building.

"The recent transition from twice per week to once per week back door service was difficult for all those involved, however, Waste Pro worked with the City to make the transition as seamless as possible," said City Engineer Marshall Boyd. "Waste Pro staff handles all situations with promptness and professionalism."
